Definitions

For the purposes of this Privacy Policy:

- Account means a unique account created for You to access our Service or parts of o ur Service.

- Cookies are small files that are placed on Your computer, mobile device or any other

Collecting and Using Your Person al Data

Types of Data Collected

Personal Data

Usage Data

Usage Data is collected automatically when using the Service.

Use of Your Personal Data

We may share Your personal information in the following situations:

- For business transfers: We may share or transfer Your personal information in conn ection with, or during negotiations of, any merger, sale of Company assets, financing, or acquisition of all or a portion of Our business to another company.
- With Affiliates: We may share Your information with Our affiliates, in which case we
 will require those affiliates to honor this Privacy Policy. Affiliates include Our parent co
 mpany and any other subsidiaries, joint venture partners or other companies that We
 control or that are under common control with Us.
- **With business partners:** We may share Your information with Our business partners to offer You certain products, services or promotions.
- With other users: when You share personal information or otherwise interact in the p ublic areas with other users, such information may be viewed by all users and may b e publicly distributed outside.
- With Your consent: We may disclose Your personal information for any other purpos
 e with Your consent.

Retention of Your Personal Data

The Company will retain Your Personal Data only for as long as is necessary for the purpos es set out in this Privacy Policy. We will retain and use Your Personal Data to the extent ne cessary to comply with our legal obligations (for example, if we are required to retain your d ata to comply with applicable laws), resolve disputes, and enforce our legal agreements and policies.

The Company will also retain Usage Data for internal analysis purposes. Usage Data is ge nerally retained for a shorter period of time, except when this data is used to strengthen the

security or to improve the functionality of Our Service, or We are legally obligated to retain this data for longer time periods.

Transfer of Your Personal Data

Your information, including Personal Data, is processed at the Company's operating offices and in any other places where the parties involved in the processing are located. It means t hat this information may be transferred to — and maintained on — computers located outsi de of Your state, province, country or other governmental jurisdiction where the data protection laws may differ than those from Your jurisdiction.

Your consent to this Privacy Policy followed by Your submission of such information represents Your agreement to that transfer.

The Company will take all steps reasonably necessary to ensure that Your data is treated s ecurely and in accordance with this Privacy Policy and no transfer of Your Personal Data will take place to an organization or a country unless there are adequate controls in place including the security of Your data and other personal information.

Disclosure of Your Personal Data

Business Transactions

If the Company is involved in a merger, acquisition or asset sale, Your Personal Data may be transferred. We will provide notice before Your Personal Data is transferred and becomes subject to a different Privacy Policy.

Law enforcement
